

Summer fashion on display



HUNDREDS of fashionistas descended on Monbulk last week for Jenny's Shoppe annual fashion parade.

Two parades were held last Thursday (17 September), revealing some of this summer's top fashion.

Funds raised from the day will go towards the Monbulk Christian Fellowship.

More than 18 models from as young as 16 to 78 took centre stage on the catwalk, showing off 120 of this summer's fashion.
